We lose more children over the age of one to cancer than any other disease. SIOPE works with health professionals in paediatric oncology to ensure investment in high-quality research is sustained and effective treatment is improved.

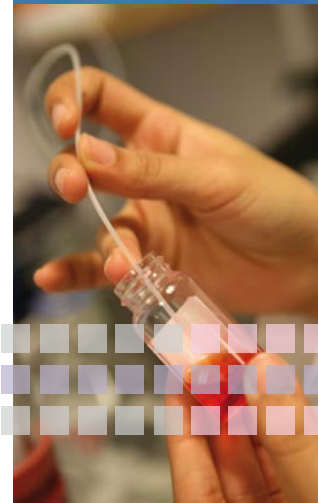
